Cleaning and Supplies for Childcare Providers (CSCP) Funds Now Available!

The Governor and Legislature have authorized funding to providers for cleaning supplies, gloves, masks, and other personal supplies necessary to protect against and reduce the spread of the Novel Coronavirus.

Providers may be either licensed providers, license-exempt centers, or home-based providers. Funding is limited and will be disbursed on a first-come, first-served basis until funds are depleted, or September 18, 2020—whichever comes first.
